

ORDINANCE 20-008

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE ACCESS OF WASTE/GARBAGE AND RUBBISH ON PUBLIC AND/OR PRIVATE PROPERTIES WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF OWENS CROSS ROADS


It shall be unlawful for any person to rummage through, remove, or salvage items from or otherwise scavenge from or tamper with any garbage containers or rubbish piles, whether located curbside or at designated drop-off or collection point, private or public properties, whether located temporarily or permanently within the town limits of Owens Cross Roads from 30 minutes prior to sunset to 30 minutes after sunrise. The scattering of any of the contents of any waste or rubbish container is also prohibited at any hour, day, or night.

Exception to this ordinance shall be as necessary for law enforcement purposes.

The mayor is hereby empowered to issue administrative regulations empowering specified employees of the town to issue notices or citations to any person if there is probable cause to believe he has violated this ordinance. Notices and citations so issued shall be personally delivered to the alleged violator or sent by certified mail if he cannot be found and shall direct the alleged violator to pay not less than \$25 or more than \$100 per violation.
