


**ORDINANCE NO. 21-001
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 06-0004**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF OWENS CROSS ROADS, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

It shall be unlawful for any owner, lessee or occupant of a premise to utilize the Owens Cross Roads sanitary sewer system without paying the mandatory \$100 deposit for services, plus the monthly sewer service charge (based on current rate).


If any owner, lessee, or occupant of a premises who utilizes the sanitary sewer system without paying the mandatory \$100 deposit for services and/or sewer service charge as billed monthly, after the same has been delinquent so that the amount due has reached at least \$300, and fails to respond to formal written requests to bring account current or fails to maintain agreed upon payment arrangement; then Owens Cross Roads Sewer Department will hire a private contractor to excavate, disconnect, and cap the offender's sewer service from the main Owens Cross Roads sewer line. All incurred costs (to include but not limited to disconnect and reconnect fees) will be added to the offender's sewer account and therefore become their financial responsibility. The Madison County Health Department will be notified at the time the sewer service is disconnected.
