ORDINANCE NO. 21-016

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING STREET LIGHTING FOR SUBDIVISIONS WITHIN OWENS CROSS ROADS, ALABAMA.

Safety clause.

Owens Cross Roads hereby finds, determines, and declares that this Ordinance is necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare of the town and the inhabitants thereof, and supersedes any existing lighting ordinances.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF OWENS CROSS ROADS, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

- I. Street lighting shall be provided in all residential subdivisions or multi-family housing units.
- II. Street lights shall be provided at all intersections and curves deemed by the Commission to be comparable to intersections, and shall be spaced at a maximum distance of 300 linear feet between said intersections as measured along the curb. Street light layout shall be coordinated with Huntsville Utilities and provided for review by the town engineer along with construction plan set for preliminary plat approval.
- III. Lighting fees are a rate of \$200 per lot and paid to the Town of Owens Cross Roads at the time of subdivision preliminary plat approval.
