



## CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS ORDINANCE NO. 21-030

### ACCESS TO THE SANITARY SEWER SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF OWENS CROSS ROADS, ALABAMA**, that all property owners of buildings and/or dwellings within the existing sanitary sewer service area who desire to have said buildings and/or dwellings connected to the sanitary sewer service provided by Owens Cross Roads will be able to connect, at their expense, to the current sewer service after paying the required sewer line tap fee in place at the time the service is connected. Users of said sewer service will pay a refundable security deposit fee for sewer service prior to commencement of service and will continue to pay regularly billed monthly fees for usage of the sewer system. In areas within the legal limits of Owens Cross Roads where sewer service is not currently available, it will be the financial responsibility of the property owner to run an approved sewer line, after paying the required sewer line tap fee, from the closest available point of the existing sewer system to the building or dwelling where service is desired.

**BE IT FUTHER ORDAINED**, that all property situated within the existing sewer service area but which is not legally annexed into the town, for which sanitary sewer service is desired for buildings and/or dwellings, must be annexed into the official limits of Owens Cross Roads prior to initiation of tapping into and installing any part of a connection to the sanitary sewer system of Owens Cross Roads. Consequences for failure to insure the property is legally annexed into Owens Cross Roads shall fall solely on the property owner(s) and Owens Cross Roads shall not be responsible for any part of monetary expenditures paid out by said property owner(s) who failed to comply with this or any other related ordinances.
