ORDINANCE NO. 22-002
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 02-02A**

Amendment to Ordinance 02-02A, heretofore known as the Owens Cross Roads, Alabama, Junk, Litter and Inoperable Vehicle and Article Ordinance.

Whereas, the Council and Mayor have determined the need for a penalty clause to be added to the above referenced Ordinance.

Therefore, a penalty of no less than \$250.00, and no more than \$500.00 (excluding daily fees) be incurred to any that have received notices or letters from the City of Owens Cross Roads and have failed to resolve the issues of said notices or letters. Should these penalties not be paid and issues not resolved, the offending party will incur an additional \$10.00 per day, per each offense that is left unresolved. Any fines not paid within three (3) months after first day of issuance of citation will lead to a lien being placed on said property. This lien will include cost of demolition of unsafe buildings, etc. as well as clean-up of the nuisance property.

This ordinance does not apply to agriculture equipment, mechanic or auto body businesses, hobbyists, or vehicles pending litigation.
