



CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS ORDINANCE NO. 22-015

SEWER VIOLATIONS ORDINANCE TO REPLACE ORDINANCE NO. 21-024

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF OWENS CROSS ROADS, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

It shall be unlawful for any owner, lessee or occupant of a premise to utilize the Owens Cross Roads sanitary sewer system without paying the mandatory \$100 deposit for owned residence, and \$150 deposit for rented residence for services, plus the monthly sewer service charge (based on current rate).

If any owner, lessee, or occupant of a premises who utilizes the sanitary sewer system without paying the mandatory \$100 deposit for services and/or sewer service charge as billed monthly, after the same has been delinquent for TWO (2) or more months, and fails to respond to formal written requests to bring the account current or fails to maintain the agreed upon payment arrangement, then Owens Cross Roads Sewer Department will hire a private contractor to excavate and disconnect the offender's sewer service from the main Owens Cross Roads sewer line. All incurred costs (to include but not limited to disconnect/reconnect fees) will be added to the offender's sewer account and therefore become their financial responsibility. Landscaping and other associated repairs will be the responsibility of the account holder. The Madison County Health Department will be notified at the time the sewer service is disconnected.
