

## CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS ORDINANCE NO. 22-024

## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE TITLE CHANGE FOR THE MUNICIPALITY KNOWN AS OWENS CROSS ROADS

Pursuant to the provisions of Code of Alabama 1975, Section 11-40-6 that states:

"Municipal corporations now existing or hereafter organized under this title containing 2,000 or more inhabitants shall be called cities. All incorporated municipalities containing less than 2,000 inhabitants shall be called towns. The last census, whether federal or taken as authorized in this title, shall be used in determining the population of a city or town."

Upon the completion of the Decennial Census that was conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau in the year 2020, the Town of Owens Cross Roads had a population count of 2,894. The Code of Alabama states that qualifies the Town to now be titled a City.

Therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of Owens Cross Roads, in the State of Alabama, that the *Town of Owens Cross Roads* shall now be titled the *City of Owens Cross Roads* from this day forth. The City shall use this title in all Ordinances, Resolutions, business transactions, and all other correspondence.
