Also, will have updated maps to manholes/sewer, etc. Two-part contract. Not to Exceed \$15K, heavily discounted due to grants, comprehensive plans are typically set for 15 years – check every 3-4 years to make sure staying on track – infrastructure moving forward, possibly a 2006 update in City Hall somewhere, haven't found a copy yet.
