



RESOLUTION 22-033

TO APPROVE AN ARPA FUNDS EXPENDITURE FOR THE OWENS CROSS ROADS POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Owens Cross Roads has received \$505,861.04 in American Rescue Plan Act Funds over the last two years; and,

WHEREAS, one of the purposes of the American Rescue Plan Act Funds is to protect our employees (especially our Police Officers in this case), and the general public by lessening close contact or exposure to germs; and,

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police is requesting the purchase of a *Data Works Evolution 5150i – tablet based integrated finger print scanner*, which will lessen the number of individuals coming into City Hall and the Police Department. The cost of this mobile finger print scanning device is \$12,641.20; and so,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Owens Cross Roads, Alabama, while in regular session on the 27th day of September, 2022, that the City Council hereby adopts Resolution 22-033 to approve the purchase using American Rescue Plan Funds.
