Resolution 23-004: Recommendation from Abatement Board

Andrew Craig, Vice-Chairman of Abatement Board presented recommendation to demolish trailer located at 440 Hill Road. Question was asked if the owners could have it removed to relieve the City of that financial burden? There are three owners, one of which was present, and she stated that she doesn't know where her mother is and that her sister, who is under the care of her father, is in another state. Matt asked if there were any orders prohibiting her sister from making decisions and she said not that she is aware of. It was recommended that we give the owner sixty (60) days to work on getting the trailer off the property before proceeding with action for the City to arrange removal. James Mann suggested that we modify the Ordinance to reflect that the owners have sixty (60) days to take care of removal and if no action in sixty (60) days, the City will proceed with removal process.

Members of Audience Canvassed by Mayor Craig

Matt Balch, City Attorney, updated that Jake Roth is getting some information to help in the Water Authority resolution. Offered both he and Tom Jarvinen's assistance in completing the AMIC questionnaire. Added that there will need to be some changes in the Employee Handbook to verify that we are addressing issues as required. James Mann says that he is looking at two consulting companies for help. Matt also mentioned the current

situation going on in Huntsville with the shooting of two police officers. Chief Dobbins stated that our police department is offering assistance by covering in the Hampton Cove and Big Cove areas.

Kenny Mitchum, who has property on Hwy 431 that backs up to the proposed Ramsay Cove subdivision, spoke about the continuing issues he is having with flooding and water retainage in his backyard. States that his sewer has not worked properly since the site work began. He has been made numerous promises from several of the folks working there, Cameron, Cantrell, and Kelly, to mention a few, that the issues would be resolved, but nothing has been done to accomplish a resolution. Mayor Craig asked for his contact information and assures that a resolution will be found.

Robert Lewis, a member of the community has a political request that he would like some assistance with. Mayor Craig said that he can get on the agenda for a work session with the council.
