



CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS ORDINANCE NO. 23-007

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO 22-019 SEWER CALL CHARGES FOR RESIDENTS

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF OWENS CROSS ROADS that any calls received for a sewer emergency will receive a thorough inspection by the City Sewer Department after the resident's licensed plumber has declared the problem is the responsibility of the City Sewer Department.

After inspection, if fault is found between the home and the main sewer line – to include the tap, that will indicate the resident's responsibility and will result in a charge of \$200 per hour spent on said emergency.

Residents at fault will be billed the first business day after the emergency call and payment will be expected within 30 days.
