Excessive Bulk Trash & Construction Debris

**AN ORDINANCE TO CLARIFY CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS DISPOSAL AND TO
SET A FEE FOR EXCESSIVE AMOUNTS OF BULK DEBRIS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS THAT:

It shall be unlawful for any contractor to place construction debris on the side of road. Construction debris MUST be discarded by the contractor. It shall be unlawful for any construction or demolition contractor to fail to provide on-site containers for loose debris, paper, building material waste, scrap building material, and other trash produced by those working on-site. Dirt, mud, demolition and construction waste, and other debris, whether located upon public or private property, shall be removed on a continuing basis as produced on the premises or in relation to a demolition or construction project, and in no case shall such waste remain on or near the premises or in relation to a demolition or construction project for a period of more than 14 days. Dirt and/or mud on public roadways must be removed within 24-hours.

Penalties for violation of this ordinance will be as follows:

- 1st offense - Citation of Ordinance Violation with \$100 fine and possible court appearance
- 2nd offense – Citation of Ordinance Violation with \$250 fine and court appearance

Contractor will still be responsible to have debris removed from side of roadway within seven (7) business days.

Residents who place excessive (more than a regular pick-up truck can haul) amounts of bulk trash debris, excluding branches resulting from storm damage, on the side of the road will be required to pay a fee of \$50 per load. Arrangements must be made with City Hall for excessively large loads to be picked up.
