

# CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS ORDINANCE NO. 24-007

**Replaces Resolution 21-04-27** 

### BACK TO SCHOOL SALES TAX HOLIDAY

AN ORDINANCE TO EXEMPT CERTAIN SCHOOL SUPPLIES, COMPUTERS, AND CLOTHING FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES TAX DURING THE DESIGNATED PERIOD ASSIGNED BY THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE, AS AUTHORIZED BY RULE 810-6-3-.65, LAW: §§40-23-210 – 213, ACT 2006-574, AND ACT 2017-120.

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF OWENS CROSS ROADS, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** In conformity with the provisions of Rule 810-6-3-.65, Law: §§40-23-210 – 213, Act 2006-574, and Act 2017-120 of the Code of Alabama 1975, providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday, the City of Owens Cross Roads, Alabama, exempts "covered items" from municipal sales tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the third Friday in July 2024 (July 19) and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday (July 21), and each year thereafter until and unless annual participation is rescinded by further action of the Council or the State of Alabama.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Rule 810-6-3-.65, Law: §§40-23-210 – 213, Act 2006-574, and Act 2017-120 of the Code of Alabama 1975.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Owens Cross Roads, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.

### Computers, computer software, and school computer supplies

### Eligible

A single purchase with a sales price of \$750 or less.

Computers - For a purchase to be eligible, a computer may include a laptop, desktop, or tower computer system which consists of a central processing unit (CPU), and devices such as a display monitor, keyboard, mouse, and speakers sold as a computer package. Computer parts and devices not sold as part of a package with the CPU, will not qualify for the exemption.

#### Computer software

School computer supplies - An item commonly used by a student in a course of study in which a computer is used. All-inclusive list includes:

- Computer storage media; diskettes, compact disks
- Handheld electronic schedulers, except devices that are cellular phones
- Personal digital assistants, except devices that are cellular phones
- Computer printers
- Printer supplies for computers (printer paper, printer ink)

### Noneligible

- Furniture
- Any systems, devices, software, peripherals designed or intended primarily for recreational use
- Video games of a non-educational nature

### School supplies, school art supplies, and school instructional material

### Eligible

Sales price of \$50 or less, per item (noncommercial purchases) This is an all-inclusive list.

### School supplies

- Calculators

- Crayons

- Folders (expandable, pocket, plastic, and manila)

Sales price of \$30 or less, per book (noncommercial purchases)

### **Books**

The term book is defined as a set of printed sheets bound together and published in a volume with an ISBN number.

#### **Noneligible**

- Magazines
- Newspapers and periodicals
- Any other document printed or offered for sale in a non-bound form
