

CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS ORDINANCE NO. 25-002

An Ordinance Regulating Construction Site Warming Fires Within the City of Owens Cross Roads, Alabama

WHEREAS, the City of Owens Cross Roads recognizes the need to provide for the safety and well-being of construction workers during the colder months; and

WHEREAS, the use of controlled warming fires on construction sites can be a safe and effective means of providing warmth for workers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish clear and concise regulations governing the use of such fires to ensure public safety and minimize the risk of fire hazards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS, ALABAMA, as follows:

Section 1. Definitions

For the purposes of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

• Construction Site Warming Fire: A contained fire for the sole purpose of providing heat and warmth to onsite construction workers, constantly attended while workers are onsite.

Section 2. Permit Requirements

Fires that are ignited between November 1st and April 30th for the purpose of providing warmth to workers at construction sites for which a building permit has been issued shall be permitted providing the following conditions are met:

- 1. **Fire Container:** The fire shall be contained in a noncombustible container not to exceed 55 U.S. gallons, with the opening covered by an ash screen.
- 2. Setbacks:
 - o Fire containers shall be located a minimum of 25 feet from any structure, dumpster, tree, or bush, or any other combustibles.
 - o Fire containers shall be located a minimum of 25 feet from electrical lines and/or electrical service.
- 3. Burning Materials:
 - o Only clean fuel not containing garbage shall be burned.
 - Burning of rubber, plastics, metals, shingles, treated lumber, or other hazardous materials is strictly prohibited.
- 4. Fire Height: Burning materials shall be no higher than the top of the container.
- 5. Fire Extinguisher: A fire extinguisher shall be located within ten feet of the fire container.
- 6. Attendant: Fires shall be extinguished when no worker is in attendance.

- 7. **Debris Disposal:** No burn debris shall be placed in construction dumpsters.
- 8. **Permit Requirement:** The contractor shall apply in advance for a safety permit issued in their name from the City of Owens Cross Roads Inspection Department. The contractor shall be held liable for all permit violations on the burn site.

Section 3. Enforcement

Any violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$100 for each offense and court costs, if necessary. Each day that a violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 4. Severability

If any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its final passage and publication as required by law.
