



# CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS ORDINANCE NO. 25-008

---

## **AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SINGLE POLLING PLACE FOR THE 2025 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN THE CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS, ALABAMA**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Owens Cross Roads desires to ensure the efficient and orderly conduct of its municipal elections; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the voters of Owens Cross Roads to designate a single polling place for the 2025 Municipal Election; and

**WHEREAS**, Owens Cross Roads City Hall, located at 9032 Highway 431 S, is a suitable and accessible location for a polling place;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OWENS CROSS ROADS, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:**

### **Section 1. Designation of Polling Place.**

For the 2025 Municipal Election to be held on August 26, 2025 and if needed, the run-off municipal election to be held on September 23, 2025, the sole polling place for the City of Owens Cross Roads shall be Owens Cross Roads City Hall, located at 9032 Highway 431 S.

### **Section 2. Purpose.**

This ordinance is enacted to consolidate polling locations and ensure a streamlined and efficient voting process for the 2025 Municipal Election.


### **Section 3. Notice.**

The City Clerk is hereby directed to provide appropriate notice of this designated polling place to all registered voters in the City of Owens Cross Roads, in accordance with applicable state and local election laws.


**Section 4. Effective Date.**
